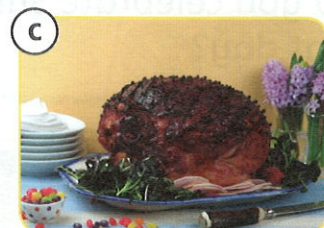
Easter in the USA
